#43. BLASTER TRAINEE I – PERMANENT MINE OPERATIONS WAGE GRADE 10 INTERDEPARTMENTAL

Under the supervision of the Blasting Supervisor, the blaster trainee will learn blasting procedures and practices. The incumbent learns how to load blast holes, connect blast hole charges as laid down, to detonate charge following the laid down procedures, and operate wiggle wagon when needed. also performs secondary blasting as required. The blaster trainee also learns to observe all safety rules and fire prevention regulations.

Currently the position is a 4 x 4 shift position; however, the incumbent may be required to work on other shifts and/or schedules.

Recent experience on fording blasting crew or valid B.C coal mine blasting certificate preferred but not necessary.
